Integrating with edit-on Pro® 2.1

WebGUI has a built-in WYSIWIG editor, but that isn't sufficient for every business' needs. For that reason we've added an integration option for RealObjects edit-on Pro® (www.realobjects.de). edit-on Pro is a very powerful editor that has many advantages over the built-in editor. They are as follows:

- Platform independent – Works on Windows 95/98/ME/NT/2000/XP, Linux, Solaris, Apple OSX, and other Java enabled platforms.
- Browser independent – Internet Explorer 4/5/6, Netscape Navigator 4.7/6.1/6.2, Mozilla, and other Java enabled browsers.
- Fully customizable – Limit your users to the functionality you want them to have such as removing certain formatting like tables, fonts, font colors, font sizes, or force them to follow XHTML 1.0 compliance.

- Fast and small – Even though it is written in java, it is small and fast because that was one of its main goals.
- Integrated spell check – Spell check your documents in four different languages.

Installation Steps

1. Download and decompress the edit-on Pro software package from www.realobjects.de.
2. Copy the folder called "eopro" from the distribution into `/data/WebGUI/www/extras/` folder.
3. Put the license file you received from RealObjects into the `/data/WebGUI/www/extras/eopro` folder.
4. Log into WebGUI with an account with admin rights.
5. **Select** Administrative functions... > Edit settings. > Edit Content Settings.
6. Switch Editor To Use to `Real Objects Edit-On Pro`.
